Minutes for May 20, 2014

ANNUAL MEETING

Called to order at 7:30pm by Kevin Baker. Also in attendance: 1st Vice President Carol-Sue Ryan, 2nd Vice President Jason McFarland, Secretary Ellen Meehan, and Treasurer Kevin Parkes.

Elections were held as required in the by-laws. Kevin Baker was re-elected as President, Carol-Sue Ryan was re-elected as 1st Vice President and Ellen Meehan was reelected as Secretary.

Annual meeting was adjourned 7:36pm.

MAY MEETING

Meeting was called to order at 7:36 by President Kevin Baker with full board in attendance.

Guest Speaker Candidate Carl Domino addressed residents about his six-way primary campaign for the Republican Party nomination to run for Florida's 18th District in the U.S. House of Representatives. The seat is currently held by Congressman Patrick Murphy.

Mr. Domino is a conservative Republican who served in the Florida House of Representatives for eight years. He spoke on multiple issues including education, safety, environment, military & veterans' benefits, energy, jobs, and the economy. Following his stump speech he took questions from the audience. 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Treasury Report The 2014 dues letter was included in the April 2014 newsletter. There has been problems with the mail being returned by the post office, which lost the PO box rental payment. The PO Box problem has been rectified by Kevin Parkes and mail can continue to be sent to Donald Ross Landowners' Association, PO Box 30638, Palm Beach Gardens, FL 33420. The association currently has approximately \$5,300 in the operating account and \$10,800 in the legal account.

Secretary Report The minutes of the March 2104 meeting was approved.

Old Business

SIRWCD Kevin Baker updated the community about the SIRWCD meeting held May 8. The SIRWCD attorney informed the board that the Governor blocked legislation allowing improvements to our park even though the local bill clearly required SIRWCD to get a written refusal from PB County to build structures in the park. The attorney gave the board an opinion that since no other government agencies had authority to improve the park that SIRWCD improving the park was implied under FL Statute's section 298 law. SIRWCD has the wish list of structures to build including the pavilion, exercise stations, and the

Regular Meeting May 8th, 2014

District Engineer Amy Eason reported that she had received and verified new petitions for construction

of asphalt roadways on approximately 2.3 miles of roadways in Palm Beach Country Estates:



- 67th Tr N between 146th Road N and 149th Pl N
- 74th Ave N between 155th Place N and 159th Ct N
- 77th Trail N between 155th Place N, and 159th Ct N
- 78th Drive N between 150th Court N and 159th Ct N
- 88th Trail N between 155th Place N and 159th Ct N
- 163rd Court N between 75th Ave N and 79th Terr N

The Board directed staff to move forward with the referenda for the Palm Beach Country Estates roadways.

Terry Lewis of the District's law firm reported that the District's legislation to allow for construction authority in the Palm Beach Country Estates park had been turned

down by the governor's staff, despite its passage by the legislature without opposition. However, he noted they have had success amending general laws and authority under the District's special act and felt there is the authority to do construction for the park.

The Board asked PBCE President, Kevin Baker, who was in attendance, to investigate costs for some of the items they are interested in for the park. Mr. Baker noted they are initially interested in a pavilion and that only cost estimates done by SIRWCD would be valid. Manager of Operations Michael Dillon said he would research costs.

District Treasurer Charles Haas presented the District's preliminary budget for the Board's review and discussion. Mr. Haas noted that depending on timing, there may not be a necessity to increase the budget for park construction this year.

Neighborhood Watch: Kevin Baker was contacted by the owner of the wooded-lot on 154thRd N just West of 85th Ave N. Palm Beach County Code Enforcement has notified the owner that people have been using his lot to ride motor cycles and swamp mudding vehicles. Trespassers have crushed trees and done other damage. Mr. Baker informed him of the Sherriff's No Trespassing program. The lot owner signed up and hereby announces that anyone found on the lot will be presumed to be trespassing and subject to immediate arrest by the Sherriff. Mr. Baker requested that COP watch this lot on their daily rounds. Mike Ryan reported only two burglaries in PBCE since our last meeting - both with same MO as the pillowcase burglary ring. There

Residents concerned about trespassing on their properties can go online with the sheriff's department and obtain an official affidavit and No Trespassing signs. Since COPS was implemented 5 years ago, we have increased monthly patrolling hours logged from 2000 miles/month to 8000 miles/month; in addition, COPS reported 233 house checks. Please continue to volunteer for this valuable neighborhood service.

The Great American Cleanup: Thank you to Carol-Sue Ryan for organizing our neighborhood cleanup on April 22. We successfully gathered more than 750 lbs of garbage with 50+ volunteers. Teenagers/students recorded 54 community service hours. Everyone enjoyed the food from Sonny's BBQ and the new picnic tables at the Park. We plan on holding another neighborhood cleanup in September.




